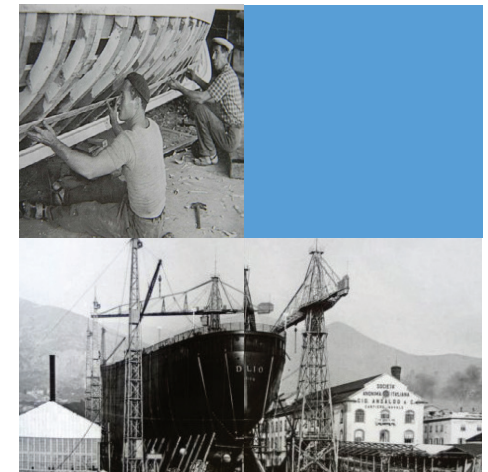
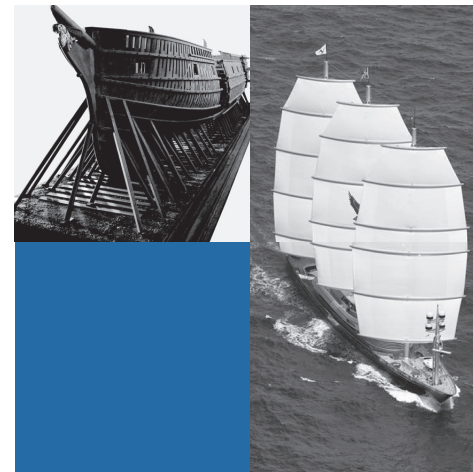
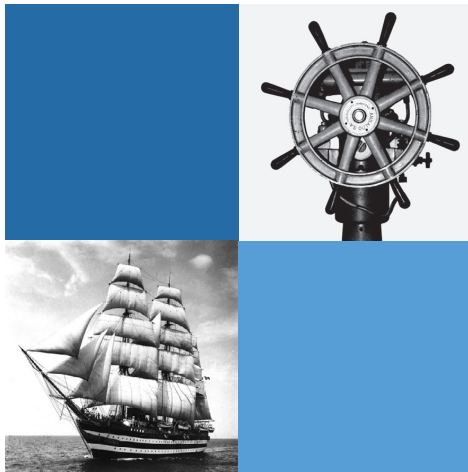

An international scientific Committee, representative of international academic and cultural institutions, will review the extended abstracts assuring the scientific quality of the conference.

Professors [Antonio Scamardella](#) (University of Naples Parthenope) and [Ernesto Fasano](#) (University of Naples Federico II) have been engaged to chair the CNM 2019 Conference Scientific Committee.

The extended abstract (max 5000 words) can be composed in either English or Italian language. After the approval, the contributors will be allowed to present their work during the conference. Extended abstracts and full papers will be collected and published in the conference proceeding. Moreover, provided that English language has been chosen, a full-length paper (max 10 pages) can be submitted to be included in the conference proceedings and indexed by [SCOPUS](#).
